

PUMPKIN DESSERT

12-oz. can evaporated milk

3 eggs, beaten

2 t. pumpkin pie spice

½ t. salt

1 c. sugar (The first time I made this, I put in the full cup. The second time, I reduced it to ¾ cup and it didn't hurt anything. We like things a little less sweet, especially when topping it off with whipped cream.)

12-oz. can pumpkin (The can I bought had 15 oz and I used it all.)

18 1/2 -oz. pkg. yellow cake mix (I used Pillsbury which has 'pudding in the mix'.)

½ c. butter

Garnish: whipped topping (Reddi Whip, extra creamy.), candy sprinkles (We skipped these.)

Combine all ingredients except cake mix, butter and garnish. Pour into a greased 13"x9" pan. Sprinkle on dry cake mix; do not stir. Dot with butter. (I melted the butter instead and then drizzled it evenly over the top.) Bake at 350 degrees for 30 to 35 minutes. Serve with whipped topping. Makes 20 squares.
